### COVID Restrictions

With the current COVID restrictions, there are limitations for Church activities. Capacity is 1 person per 4m<sup>2</sup> which means that 55 people are allowed in the down stairs worship area and 15 people on the balcony, if needed the Hall will be opened up. As singing is **not** allowed, during worship services music and or a video will be played for reflective listening. **Wearing of masks is mandatory.** Please do not crowd anyone. Handshaking and hugging is discouraged. All are asked to sign in via the QR code or paper form when entering the Church premises. As people must be seated to eat and drink, there are new arrangements for the distribution of Holy Communion. A Pastoral Assistant will come around to each worshiper in their seats and give out the wafer and a cup with wine or grape juice. Once distributed the Pastor will say a blessing and all then can partake of communion. Communion cups will be collected after the blessing. If you are unwell, for the care of the rest of our Church family please stay at home.
